


Garage Door Measuring Guide



Width - To be taken from brick to brick for all roller and sectional doors. For up and over and side hinged doors take the brick to brick size for framed doors. For doors fitting to an existing timber frame take the timber frame to frame size.

Height- To be taken from a level floor (if floor is not level take the shortest measurement) up to the underside of any lintel or to the existing timber frame if the new door is being fitted to this.

Side Clearance - Needed for all roller and sectional doors. Also for other doors if fitting the frame behind the brick reveal.

Headroom - To be taken from the bottom of the lintel to the ceiling or to any joists/supports which would cause obstruction of the door.

Travel - Needed for retractable up and over doors and sectional doors. Check from the back of the lintel to the back of the garage noting any obstructions.
